Folate	✓	✓				Rukau, rukau viti, broccoli, beans, lentils, citrus fruits, papaya. 	Helps with your baby's development and lowers risk of spina bifida.
Iron		✓	✓	✓		Eat 2 servings of iron rich foods <b>daily</b> such as rukau, eggs and red meats. 	Lowers the risk of premature birth and low birth weight for baby; and anaemia in the mum.
Vitamin D		✓	✓	✓	✓	From being in the sun or eating dairy products. 	Essential for bone development and skeletal health.
Omega-3		✓	✓	✓	✓	Eat 2-3 servings <b>each week</b> of fish (avoid high mercury fish). 	Good for brain development and reducing allergies in your child.
